

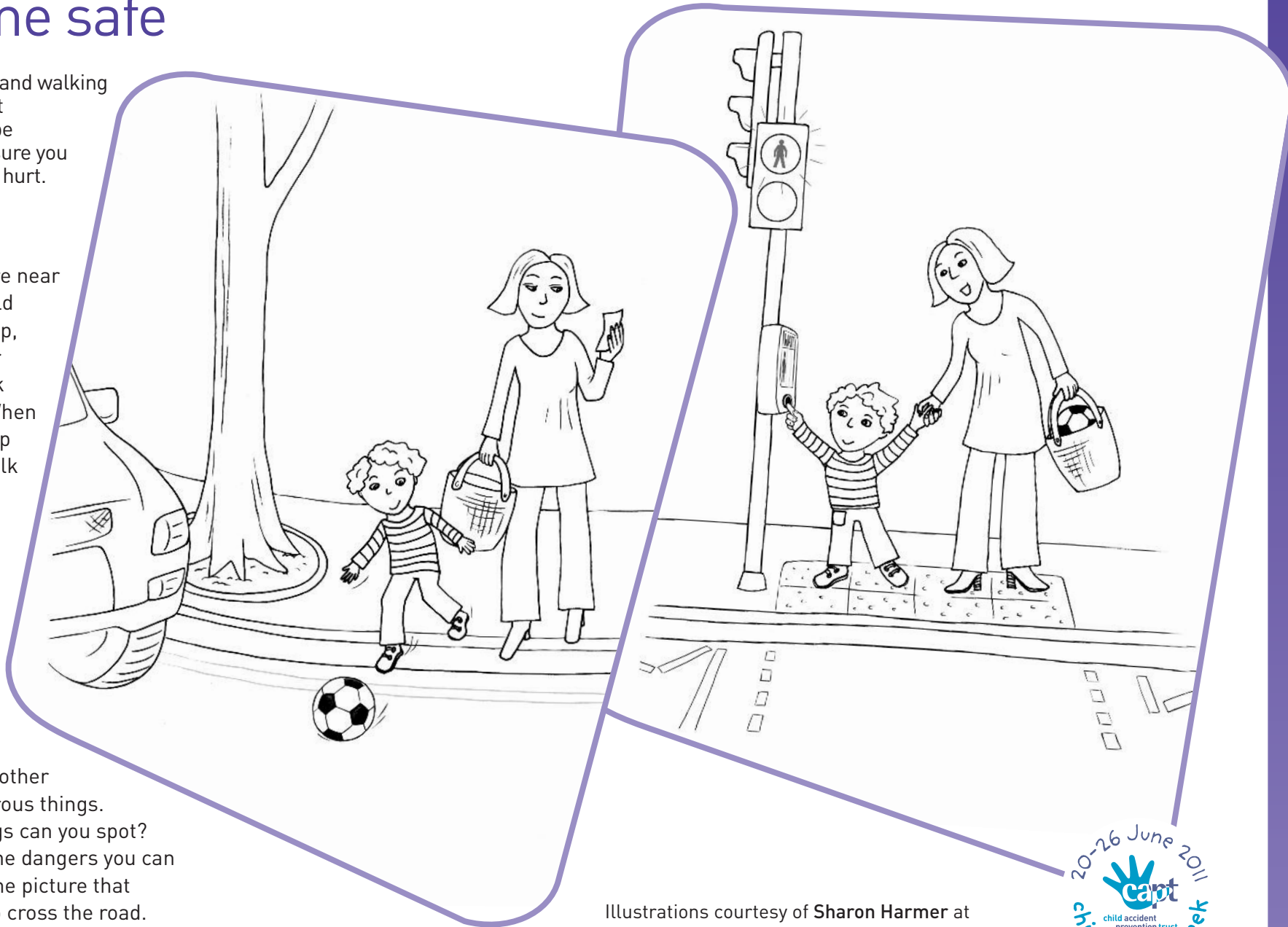
Colour me safe

Going out is great fun, and walking is very good for you but remember roads can be dangerous. So make sure you stay safe and don't get hurt.

Remember

Stay safe when you are near the roads. Always hold hands with a grown-up, and keep hold of their hand as you stop, look and listen for cars. When it is safe to cross, keep hold of their hand, walk – don't run and keep looking and listening until you get to the other side

Look at the two pictures of a child crossing the road with a grown-up. In one of the pictures they are crossing the road safely but in the other they are doing dangerous things. What dangerous things can you spot? Draw a circle round the dangers you can see. Then colour in the picture that shows the safe way to cross the road.
