Seeing their child learn to crawl, shuffle or walk is a very exciting time for all parents but it can be a worrying time too. Children often surprise their parents with the speed at which they can move, or get into things and for many children the stairs become a mountain they must, must, must climb!

That's why it is important for parents to fit safety gates once their child starts to explore their home. As well as fitting safety gates at the bottom of the stairs, they can be used in other areas too, like across the kitchen door to stop your child getting in whilst you are cooking, or across the landing to keep them away from the top of the stairs.
